If you are an employee (full- or part-time, temporary or permanent), this leaflet explains what your rights are, what you should expect from your employer, what responsibilities you have and where to go for help.

It also applies to you if you are a young person doing work experience, an apprentice, charity worker, mobile worker or home worker.

If you are a temporary, casual or agency worker, the employment business agency, contractor or hirer you are working for has a legal duty to ensure you receive the rights set out here.
