

## **Workplace Mapping outcome**

**Workplace Mapping is now completed and we would like to thank all the people who participated in this safety initiative.**

**It has taken 19 months to complete, and through that period of time we have come across a lot of difficulties that have slowed down the completion of jobs, e.g. changes in management, changes in engineering staff, redundancies and cost cutting.**

**Even though we have had to endure these difficulties, Powder has resolved 60% of the 313 issues that were originally raised. A further 9 have been allocated to the cage project that is currently running. The cage project has been formed to try and find ways of reducing the amount of time operators have to enter the cage area.**

**Reasons for mapping issues that have not been resolved have been put on the final Mapping list. Management, engineering and safety reps discussed these issues, before a decision was made. Safety Reps would have liked to have had more issues resolved, and have put several in writing to management, but a site decision was made to end Mapping at the end of December, which has left us in this final position.**

**Issues that have not been completed will not be forgotten. Any plant changes that happen in the future will look at the mapping issues that still need completing. Also records of these issues will be kept for future reference.**

**We have not had many site initiatives that have ended with completion; mapping is one of a few, so once again we would like to thank all who contributed to this safety initiative.**
